

Climb to Fight Breast Cancer® Cancellation Policy

Due to the costs associated with the Climb and the limited availability of climber spots, the Climb to Fight Breast Cancer must adhere to a strict cancellation policy. ***Please note the registration fee (due at time of registration) and all donations received are non-refundable as well, regardless of the reason for cancellation.***

- *Cancellation by Fundraising Midpoint:* Climber cancellations will be processed if notice is received by the date noted below by peak. Climbers who cancel by the date noted will not be responsible for the fundraising commitment. Any donations received up to the point of cancellation will support breast cancer research at FHCRC regardless of the reason for withdrawal.
- *Cancellation After Fundraising Midpoint:* After date noted below by peak, climbers must raise the full fundraising commitment or have the difference charged to their credit card on file.
- *In Case of Personal Injury:* FHCRC reserves the right to carry over a climber's eligibility to the following year. In such cases, a doctor's note or other related documentation is required in writing by the date of the participant's intended climb and fundraising minimums must still be met as noted on previous pages. Please email Lisa Carlson at ljcarlso@fhcrc.org to alert her the letter is coming. If you do not submit a doctor's note by the date of your intended climb, FHCRC will not carry over your climb. Note: Eligibility to climb is valid for one year only. *Should you carryover your eligibility, you will not be able to compete for fundraising prizes for the following year.*

Monday, November 23, 2009 Denali

Wednesday, February 3, 2010 Mts Elbrus and Kilimanjaro

Friday, April 2, 2010 Mts Adams, Baker, Hood, Rainier, Shasta and the Volcanoes of Mexico
